Anna Odone (MD MSc MPH PhD) is Full Professor and Director of the School of Public Health at the University of Pavia. She is a member of the Italian Supreme Health Council (CSS) and of the Ministry of Health 2021-2025 National Immunization Prevention Plan Working Group.
